



GENTERA ANNOUNCES THE DECISION MADE BY FITCH RATINGS

Mexico City, Mexico, March 25, 2021 – GENTERA, S.A.B. de C.V., (“GENTERA”) (BMV: GENTERA*) informs that Banco Compartamos S.A. I.B.M., the main subsidiary of GENTERA, was affirmed today in its Viability Rating (VR), Long-Term Foreign and Local Currency Issuer Default Ratings (IDRs), and the National Long-Term and Short-Term ratings, keeping the negative outlook, by the rating agency FITCH Ratings (“FITCH”).

Fitch Ratings affirmed Banco Compartamos Ratings:

- Long-term foreign and local currency IDRs ‘BB+’;
- Short-term foreign and local currency IDRs ‘B’;
- Viability Rating at ‘bb+’ ;
- Support Rating affirmed at ‘5’;
- Support Rating Floor at ‘NF’.
- National scale long-term, senior unsecured, and short-term ratings were affirmed at ‘AA(mex)’ and ‘F1+(mex)’ respectively.

According to the press report issued, Fitch Ratings stated:

“...The bank’s leading franchise and long track record in the microfinance segment is also a highly important factor. Compartamos’ ratings also considers the highly profitable business, which was hit sharply by the effects of the pandemic in 2020, and its good funding and liquidity profile. Compartamos’ strong and sustained capitalization is a rating strength and absorbed losses during the current economic stress...”

(formerly Compartamos, S.A.B. de C.V.) is a holding company whose primary objective is to promote, organize and manage companies, domestic and international, that are subject to its investment policies. GENTERA was established in 2010 and is headquartered in Mexico. Its shares began trading on the Mexican Stock Exchange on December 24, 2010 under the ticker symbol COMPARC*. On January 2, 2014, the ticker symbol was changed to GENTERA*.
